BROAD COVERAGE OF CEE/SEE RELEVANT CONTENT

As of 2023, CEEOL covered around **2,700** Humanities journal titles from **34** countries, with articles published in more than **30** languages. The CEEOL coverage is growing monthly by **4,000** newly included journal articles. Significant number of the included journals are represented with complete archival collection.

The CEEOL eBook collection development started in 2016 and offering and evergrowing number of eBooks, as well current year as backlists of the publishing houses.
