#### BROAD COVERAGE OF CEE/SEE RELEVANT CONTENT

As of 2023, CEEOL covered around **2,700** Humanities journal titles from **34** countries, with articles published in more than **30** languages. The CEEOL coverage is growing monthly by **4,000** newly included journal articles. Significant number of the included journals are represented with complete archival collection.

The CEEOL eBook collection development started in 2016 and offering an ever-growing number of eBooks, as well current year as backlists of the publishing houses.
